Tech Report:

- Failed one car for battery. Another car had to fix battery.
- One helmet confiscated but not claimed at end of day.

Fastrack:

• All the class changes for 2017 are in this fastrack. Lot's of shaking up in the Street classes

Treasurer

- 182 participants (including DB) plus the Rookie Skool on the previous day.
- Audit not submitted yet.
- Only gave out 3 free DB to the skool workers. We did not allow free entry for skool participants this year.

Last event (HPA in October)

- One of our biggest events. Started pretty much on time, we had 4 runs with one timing issue.
- Setup had some delays with the sweeper layout during course testing.
- What worked better at registration this time was there was a worker walking the line with the HPA waiver but when that person wandered off that fell apart.
- Daniel's wife ran the registration since the Beaird's were away.
- We will try having a separate line for weekend memberships at the waiver line. If we have a sign that sticks up above head height, we could get the folks in the correct line. No volunteers to build the sign yet.
- The FM radio worked very well for the remote speakers with the small generator. We will order a spare.
- There was a worker that walked off the course who was dehydrated and we put him in the truck for a while.

Next event (October 2nd at HPA)

- We need more fold up metal chairs for registration. The old SCCA storage that we closed down had a few along with a table. Robert will set them out for Peter to pick up. Peter will get the tech box from Andy. Peter will set up tech on Saturday 7:00 to 7:50. He can be there Saturday with the chairs.
- Pappa Hedderick brings the committee radios and he charges them at home. The corner radios charge in the morning when we plug in the generator.
- Daylight savings time fall back on Saturday night so we may have some folks show up an hour early. Mention this at the drivers meeting.
- Put double drivers down the line and single drivers in the square paved area. Also rotate the drawing of cars for single.
- The first 4 turns are all the same size/speed. Might be a bit boring. If we could have one of those changed that would be peachy.
- The ghosted lines are 25', some of these gates look like 15'. We will get the usual complaints if we don't give them a touch more room.
- The weather will be lovely.
- DLB does not keep track of whether someone signs up without a membership for both days. It says it is a weekend membership so they should not pay the \$15 twice but that is very hard for someone to manage at registration.
- Put the truck on map.
- Raymond will see if he can get a food truck to show up.
- Probably have the wire as a backup but we will try to get the wireless working.
- Show up at 7:00 on Saturday.

Other business

- We need the committee voting by the members completed in 2 weeks or so. One more event for volunteers or nominations. Robert will set up a Survey Monkey for the vote and announce on Facebook. Put out the full list of nominees to the ballot on Facebook and the committee email.

- Put a write in for all positions, not just the ones we currently have open.
