



Houston SCCA Solo Committee Meeting Minutes 1 NOV 2017

Tech Report:

- 1 helmet failed; it was replaced with SCCA loaner
- 1 battery failed which was fixed on site

Fastrack:

- **Street and Touring:** Fuel may not exceed 93 octane (variance up to +.9) and cannot contain more than 15% ethanol. Maximum dba is still 100. At 96 chief steward will be notified
- **Car classing:** Lotus elise sc and exige s (except x260, and club racer) removed from exclusion list into SS. Lexus IS (all except IS-F) models to be moved into DS. Making ST HOT again. All competitors to check tire sizes (updated). STAC is recommending moving Porsche Boxter (986 & 987.1 M.Y. 1997-2008), Boxter s (97.M.Y.2006-2008) from STU to STR
- **Street Mod:** Engine blocks must be a production unit sources from a production automobile. If the engine does not come from same brand as vehicle, 150 lb weight penalty will be assessed.
- **Street Touring:** wording clarified in regards to after-market ECU's. You may run a proprietary tune that SCCA has no access to. Will allow ANY ECU including stand-alone computers and programmers. ECU must be plug and play (no splices) with the OBD2 port remaining functional. And only OE sensor equipped from factory may be used.
- Check car class listing. SSR added 15-20 car models
