Tech Report:

- Chris Levitz stepped in for Andy.
- Had to confiscate some more helmets, no SNELL rating, some were not picked up at the end of the event.

Fastrack:

- Discontinue 1 year SS license, 3 year license only from now on, and meeting the continuing education requirements. The SSS must take class once during 3 year and act as SSS during 5 events. The national website under the profile has a page for keeping track of which events you have worked as Safety Steward.
- Course speed wording was changed.
- Move M5 from BS to FS.
- Non-S Mini reclassing.
- STU wheel width and tire width out for comments.
- STP (modern American muscle car class) out for comments.
- Street Touring proposal to allow replacement of OEM radiator.
- Street Touring proposal to allow replacement of OEM steering wheel. It does not require an air bag but it does have to weigh at least as much as OEM.

Treasurer:

- Cash on hand \$24,774.
- We have not paid the last sanction yet. We have to do some more calculations. Roughly \$1700.
- We have to give back a bunch of \$ due to the cancellation of the Sunday event.
- Since July we spent \$4662 on new equipment, FM transmitters, generator, sound board, radios, etc.
- Race America extended warranty was \$686, \$598 for repairs. Upgraded firmware on all the items we sent in, timing lights, display, and board are already back. They have people on call if we call up during an event. No one remembers ever calling them though.

Last Month:

- We set up and tested by roughly 8:10 but the registration forced us to delay the start.
- We had to make some minor tweaks to the course.

Course Review for December

- December is now a double regional.
- Slalom along concession stand needs first cone to have pointer or else it is an optional slalom.
- Same slalom is 75' then 55', 55', 75'. Was that intentional? It was intentional but Andy intended closer to 60'. We will open the spacing to 60'.
- Finish wall corner needs to be 100' from start area instead of 75'.
- We can't be less than 25' from the grass since there is a ditch there even though we are running alongside.
- Where we go around the light pole make that wall connect.
- The finish section might be too fast. Andy will look at it.
- Second day
- Restrict driver from getting closer than 50' from light pole.
- Suggest that we soften the turn at the heel of the boot.
- Suggest that we have the tunnel the first time through the crossover and just a hole for the second time through.
- Roger thinks that both courses are transition heavy versus sweeper. Day 1 is more transition than day 2.
- We may swap the day 1 and day 2 courses. We would like the simpler setup on day 1.
