- Recommended Items
 - o Street Prepared
 - Move from CSP to DSP
 - Ford Fiesta ST (2014-18)
- Member Advisories
 - o Street
 - The SAC is anticipating one or more openings, and the SEB invites interested members to submit their qualifications in writing via <u>www.soloeventsboard.com</u>
 - \circ SSC
 - If the car did not come from the factory with specific RS 1.0 & Series.Blue parts, those parts may not be added.
 - Street Touring
 - Clarification: It is permitted to remove, re-program, and re-install a chip into the ECU provided that you are re-installing the original chip.
- Out for Comments
 - Street Prepared
 - Blow-off valves, and pop-off valves are considered part of the air intake system and may be added, replaced, or updated/backdated independently of other components of a forced induction system.
 - Outer tie rod ends and toe links may be modified or replaced but must attach to the original factory location(s) with no additional modification.
 - Street Modified
 - SSM wording
 - Eliminates confusing list of included cars like the Mclaren and Porsches
 - Eliminates wording about the list of cars not allowed in SP
 - Allows all US sold Lotus cars
 - Eliminates 2 seat requirement which allows all Porsches
 - o Prepared
 - Combining the 1988-91 Honda Civic and CRX onto the same line to allow members to use functionally similar engine components on either vehicle.
 - Line classing for Porsche 924S & 944 4-cyl 8-valve
 - A new proposal to allow older Prepared cars to update to more modern engines as various parts are getting harder to source.
