Tech Report:

- No tech report.

Fastrack:

- Water oil separators are allowed in Street.
- STU changes to tire width and wheel width.

Proposed changes:

- No tire blankets or insulation is allowed before the first competitive run.
- "Front bumpers, rear bumpers, body trim pieces and attachment points may be reinforced to
 prevent or repair damage from hitting cones. Reinforcements that are not visible to the exterior of
 the car are allowed provided they do not serve any other purpose. Modifications that change the
 exterior appearance in any way are not permitted."
- Some Boxster/Cayman proposed move from AS to BS.
- Proposal to move base Corvette C7 from SS to AS.
- Proposal to move Cayman S from SS to AS.
- SA2000 helmets are still allowed.

Treasurer:

- Cash on hand \$23,260 without having paid sanction for November.
- No bill from the track, possibly due to them scheduling a concert over our Sunday event. We did not receive a bill for April either. If RPR charges us we will end up clearing \$488 for the Saturday event.
- \$398 from Wayne for various expenses.

Last Month:

- 85 entries including DBs. Almost not enough to do 3 heats. RPR canceled the Sunday part of our event. Tents and equipment for the music event were all over the place in the way. We had to modify the course on the day of. Trucks were parked where we did not expect. The setup went well and the problems that came up were handled without many problems.
- The rain stopped during first heat.
- The guard house was open so the waiver folks had a place out of the weather.
- We started about ½ hour late. No timing delays. The location of the truck was good and timing could see everything.

Next event

- Will need to do setup on Saturday at RPR at 6:30 AM. Same setup crew as last time.
- Texas MR2 club will be attending as a club class.
- Ricardo will not be there. Cash for Saturday belongs in one envelope, Sunday in a separate envelope. Raymond will be taking the cash back.
- Maps are on dropbox. These are Andy's course that we already reviewed with the changes that we discussed at the last committee meeting.
- We did not get portacans but the concert had them and we used them. Committee decided to spend \$200 for portacans.
- Daniel is scheduled to fly back on Friday so he might not show or might be sick. ZBarnes will be the event chair in case Daniel does not make it.
