# Houston SCCA Solo Committee meeting minutes 07Jul2015

## **Tech Report:**

• No fails reported. Two people handling numbers, which did not always match what was in the computer. The printouts downloaded from DLB by registration did not match the DLB downloaded by timing for some unknown reason.

### Fastrack:

- SCB town hall announced.
- Cannot remove OEM mud flaps.

### Treasurer:

- June numbers: cash incoming from event of \$3580, paypal of \$2150, and checks for \$320 for total of \$6050
- Expenses of \$3408 for positive cash flow of \$2602
- \$26885 in bank. After sanction, fees, and amount we owe for magnets will result in about \$24K in bank.

# Last Month:

- Some of the corner captains are not adjusting when some workers are doing risky things (not being fast enough, a little closer than we would like to the course, rookie that should not be standing by himself).

- Let's get the truck placement correct this time, even if we need to move it.
- Safety steward will talk to corner captains at heat switchover. After worker chief checks them in, Raymond will send them over to Robert or whoever is safety steward at the time.
