Course Map Review

Feb course review at GGP

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- 1st sweeper needs pointer on the wall so the driver has to be outside the wall.
- 3rd cone on slalom after the 1st sweeper needs a pointer.
- On the sharp elevation area near the trees, there is an area that we may need to adjust during setup to ensure that we don't have cars going across too fast at the elevation change.
- Whataburger sweeper needs pointer on the wall to force the driver to go outside the wall.
- Finish is ok, entry to the finish looks slow but scale is about 1.5 larger than RPR. Stop box is aimed at the grid but it is long. Suggest that we widen the entry of the stop box and narrow it down, that will cause the drivers to slow down sooner.
- Mar course review HPA
 - Lots of discussion about the 90 degree at the end of the first slalom. We should slow the cars a bit between the slalom and the 90.
 - We could put the truck on the gravel drive near the bottom of where the scale is located on the drawing.
 - Slalom walls (2) are suggested in the middle of the on camber turn right before the crossover which should slow the car enough. There is concern that the 50-55 MPH entry from on camber to off camber 90 degree turn. Raymond will do speed estimation/analysis of the map.

Misc.

- We will use regional STO rules for the CAM class with the middle PAX value.
- Daniel will add a Facebook post about the CAM decision.
- There is a proposal that for the region we use the 140 tread wear rating, and not change to 200. National minimum is 200 for 2015. Federal tires will stay at 140, the other tire brands will be changed to 200. Hedderick and a couple of others have asked for a regional waiver. The concern is that new folks might be misled into buying the wrong tires for a National event. Decision is that for 2015 regionally you can run 140 so that drivers can use up old tires. We will announce the regional waiver at next driver meeting. Robert has updated the Houston Operations Manual.
- Party at Rogers house.
 - We will have a solo party where people can talk driving, solo, rules, whatever and have a beer. Roger picked the 17th of January. There will be an open invite on Facebook. Daniel will send words to Roger tomorrow and he will add them to the map for this weekend. Assuming 30-35 folks will attend. \$500 budget is approved, Roger and Ricardo will discuss it.
